Why?	Marketing companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.		
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or services you have with us. This information can include:		
	 Social Security number - Email address - Account numbers - Date of Birth - Beneficiaries 		
How ?	All marketing companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we will list the reasons Marketing companies can share their members' personal information, the reasons Franklin Madison chooses to share, and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does Franklin Madison protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Franklin Madison collect my personal information?	 We collect your personal information, for example, when your financial institution provides it to us for marketing when you enroll in one of our products when you provide it to our call center agents when you provide it on our website
Why can't I limit all sharing?	 Federal law gives you the right to limit only sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes— information about your creditworthiness. affiliates from using your information to market to you. sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you. State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <i>PenFed does not share with our affiliates.</i>
Nonaffiliates	 Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Nonaffiliated companies we share with can include insurance companies, direct marketing companies, non-profit organizations, and credit card networks.
